St Mary's NHS Trust**

I started at St Mary's Hospital, Paddington on the 1st January 2005. From the beginning, I have endeavoured to develop the Foot & Ankle service at St Mary's. We now have a first class day surgery unit, where the majority of forefoot surgery is undertaken, with the use of regional anaesthetic techniques. I now run a weekly specialised Foot & Ankle Clinic, with the addition of a specialised physiotherapy practitioner and a soon to be appointed podiatrist, as well as a multidisciplinary complex clinic.

With the assistance of the physiotherapy practitioner, we manage the entire spectrum of Foot & Ankle disorders from simple bunions to complex revision surgery. The complex cases range from primary hindfoot and midfoot fusions, to total ankle replacement and complex post traumatic deformity. I also provide a tertiary referral service for complex trauma from the surrounding London Hospitals, with rapid access for the Chelsea & Westminster, Royal Free and Charing Cross hospitals.

Each month, I have a multidisciplinary diabetic foot clinic joined by a Consultant Diabetologist, Consultant Vascular Surgeon, Consultant Neurologist, a podiatrist and an orthotist. This provides a wonderfully specialised service for our diabetic patients and those with other neuropathic conditions.

My training in Foot & Ankle surgery includes a one year fellowship under the expert tuition of Dr Terence Saxby, one of the worlds leading Foot & Ankle surgeons. This was a comprehensive fellowship covering all areas of Foot and Ankle Surgery, including trauma, adult reconstructive surgery, and sports medicine (including arthroscopy). This is the only Australian Orthopaedic Association approved fellowship in Foot & Ankle surgery. My particular areas of interest are cartilage reconstruction (mosaicplasty) and ankle replacement surgery, and I have set up an international link with a highly regarded ankle arthroplasty centre in France.

I am a member of the British Orthopaedic Association, the British Orthopaedic Foot and Ankle Society, and the American Orthopaedic Foot & Ankle Society. At St Mary's, I am a member of the Board for 'Planning the Inpatient Journey', which aims to streamline the Orthopaedic services and also a member of the Board for the care of elderly patients with fractured femurs. I am faculty member of AO and lecture at National forums on Foot & Ankle Surgery, including the Royal Society of Medicine.
